DV-100 Other Orders

CEASE NONCONSENSUAL PORN: Respondent ordered to take down from the internet and destroy all photos in his possession of Petitioner's "intimate body parts," which includes "any portion of the genitals . . . that is either uncovered or clearly visible through clothing." (California Penal Code 647(j)(4)). Specifically, this order applies to: (1) the picture on [insert website URL] described in Petitioner's DV-100 Recent Abuse declaration; (2) the picture on [insert website URL] described in Petitioner's DV-100 Recent Abuse declaration; and (3) any other photos in Respondent's possession that capture "intimate body parts" of the Petitioner as defined by statute.

Comment [WMC2]: Instruction 2:

Attach one copy to your Form DV-100 and attach another copy to your partially completed Form DV-110 so that the judge can simply check the box for Other Orders and write: "CEASE NONCONSENSUAL PORN and CEASE IMPERSONATION," and that will incorporate by reference your Other Orders proposed here that have been adopted as the order of the court for your case.

Comment [WMC3]: Practice Tip 1:

Provide a definition for nonconsensual porn (if your state has a civil or criminal revenge porn law, cite to that law), and describe specifically which of the content posted by the perpetrator constitutes nonconsensual porn and attach PDF printouts to DV-100 Recent Abuse.

Comment [WMC4]: Practice Tip 2:

It is much easier to take down NCP content than it used to be. A growing number of tech companies will voluntarily take down NCP on their platforms, regardless of whether the victim owns the copyright or has a court order regarding the content. See Without My Consent's Take Down resources. It is still, however, a recommended best practice to include the URLs for the sites you want delisted, or the accounts you want closed, and to expressly ask the court to require the restrained person to remove the content. Including the URL in the order allows the technology company to verify that the content you're referencing is the same content the court entered an order about.

DV-100 Sample Recent Abuse

On January 2, 2015, at 4:11 a.m., sexually explicit photos of me were posted to [insert website URLs] without my consent. PDF printouts of the webpages are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. I know that Ex-romantic Partner posted these photos because [here are some frequently encountered scenarios]:

- (1) [Ex-romantic partner] sent 7 texts between 10:00pm and 4:00am. Screen shots of those texts are attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.
- (2) [Ex-romantic partner] took these photos and is the only person I have ever given the photos to.
- (3) [Ex-romantic partner] has threatened me with the photos in the past. For example, [insert specifics].
- (4) The 4:00am text states, "You'll be sorry." See **Exhibit B**. The photos were posted 11 minutes later at 4:11 am. See **Exhibit A**.
- (5) The event happened the day after [Ex-romantic Partner] found out that I was dating someone new.

Comment [WMC2]: Instruction 1:
On your Form DV-100, Item 27, (1) describe the most recent abuse; (2) check the box for more space; and (3) write "See DV-100 Recent Abuse for details and evidence."

Create a word document like this sample titled DV-100 Recent Abuse. In this document, use your completed WMC Evidence Chart to help you draft your description of recent abuse. For each event, apply the following formula:

Comment [WMC3]: Practice Tip 1: Remember that anything you write, and any exhibits you attach, will be made a public record; so, if you want to try to submit some exhibits under seal, you might want to consider filing a motion, or, if you have some tolerance for uncertainty, you could employ the "just do it" approach and see what happens. If you opt for the "just do it" approach, you could state in your DV-100 Recent Abuse: "*I have provided printouts of certain Exhibits for the judge to review in private in the enclosed sealed envelope, as they are sexually explicit images of me that do not belong in the public record (Confidential Information under Civil Code section 1708.85).*" Then, place the confidential exhibits in a sealed envelope included with your motion, with the legend "Private/Confidential Exhibits" on the envelope.

Comment [WMC4]: Practice Tip 2: Do It Yourself PDFs and screen shots are admissible in court. But if you'd rather have a third party handle the capture and production of evidence, there's a service for that!

Page Vault <https://www.page-vault.com/> offers "webpage capture services." A representative will work with you to capture, store, and produce webpage captures, which can then be attached to a police report, restraining order application, or given to a lawyer for a consultation.
